

Brentwood Alumni Association Awards Two Scholarships






Ground was broken and the new gym started to rise!

A Thespian Moves on to Celluloid ...A Brentwood Alumnus Takes on Hollywood

Flashback to 1974 --- Brentwood High School Auditorium--- A tall, dark and handsome high-school senior projects his lines to an audience of family, faculty, and friends. He feels right at home on center stage. Heck, he caught the acting bug years ago. His name is Bruce Young, and one day he'll appear in movies like "Risky Business", and "The Color of Money" with Tom Cruise. Block Busters such as "Basic Instinct", "An Innocent Man", and "Phenomenon" will also be listed on his resume. All this from a young man voted "Most Dramatic" in the 1974 Eagle yearbook.

Another *small town kid makes good* story.

Throughout high school, he assisted with children's drama classes at the old Brentwood Recreation Center on Annalee Avenue. After graduating in 1974, he went to Illinois State University to join their theatre department. He later moved to California, and in 1981 created a production at The Organic Theatre Company. In this "Dungeon Masters", the actors and the audience interact in an improvisational setting. It's just one of the ways he continues teaching and entertaining, while allowing creative expression for all those involved. (It is still being performed, but has moved to another venue.)

Bruce also does television, and has had roles in such shows as *Murder, She Wrote, Diagnosis Murder* and *Hghlander*. Bruce has gone on to guest star in such currently popular television shows as *NYPD Blue, The Drew Carey Show, and Becker*, just to mention a few. He also starred in UPN's *The Sentinel* which shows on The SciFi Channel in syndication.

In a recent interview Bruce said, "In ten years I'd like to be retired, running my own theater company. Dream big! I want to get back to the Midwest ... the Midwest is where my roots are." His mother, brother Duane (BHS'82) and other family members still live in the St. Louis area.

Peace Corps Volunteer and Writer

Joyce Rinck Arneson '59 always wanted to be a journalist. After marriage and family, Joyce joined the Peace Corps in Jamaica. Through that experience Joyce achieved her goal, in part at least, by writing a novel based on her experiences. Co-authored with her husband, Don, Joyce's book, *Soon Come*, is the story of a middle-aged woman who, along with her husband gives up a comfortable life to join the Peace Corps. Through the years, the heroine, Beth Ohlsson, faces many struggles and life changes.

Joyce, as a Peace Corps Volunteer, set up a doll factory and taught the Jamaican girls how to run a business. Through her connections in St. Louis and the Rotary Club in Minneapolis, she was able to provide sewing machines for the girls and a van for transporting the dolls to souvenir shops for sale.


